Old Business:

- 1. The results of the referendum were in favor of a merger. SSCC will meet on September 21st and will vote to determine if the merger is administratively feasible. If voted yes, advertising for new board members can start.
- 2. H. Hutchinson reported on the MASCD Summer Meeting that was held on August 27th-29th in Cambridge, MD.

Each set of training trunks is \$1000. Orders must be placed by September 30th.
